

ORGANIC MEDIUM PRODUCTION



Interwaste, through its' Earth2Earth Organics division, annually diverts from landfill over 300,000 tonnes of organic material, primarily waste bark discarded by the paper and pulp industry. This, together with domestic greens collected at landfill sites and garden-waste transfer stations, goes to produce in excess of 50,000 cubic metres of export-graded compost and growing mediums every month. The majority of E2E product has been officially organic certified by the BioOrg authority.



Earth2Earth is the largest producer of organic growing mediums in southern Africa. A combined average stockholding of over a half million cubic metres allows it to reliably supply the needs of the local and export market on a year-round basis.

The quality and consistency of all Earth2Earth product is benchmarked against the highest international standards. The scale and sophistication of the group infrastructure ensures that the company can offer the highest quality product and the highest levels of service across its' range of operations.

Organics Production

The raw material is formed into long windrows and is allowed to compost naturally for a minimum of six months. Regularly turning the windrows allows an optimum supply of moisture and oxygen to permeate the stack. This enables the composting and natural pasteurisation process to be completed, rendering the final material free of weeds, harmful pathogens and micro-organisms.

The material is then screened and blended with organic supplements to produce high quality growing mediums. At every stage of the production process, Earth2Earth products are subjected to stringent controls ensuring the consistency and export quality demanded by growers and horticulturists.

Packing and Distribution

On completion of final blending and quality control the various mediums are packed for distribution. At its main production centre the company utilises an efficient state-of-the-art automated packing line ensuring quality and consistency. Bagged product is palletised for distribution or is containerised for export to customers in Africa and the Middle East. Bulk product is loaded for transport in 50m³ walking-floor trailers.
