Transfer Station Management



Interwaste manages many transfer stations on behalf of municipalities in Gauteng and the Western Cape. Originally planned to be primary collection centers for the garden refuse of local inhabitants, the scope of their operations has expanded to incorporate the growing need to minimise waste by recycling. The company manages the collection and processing of organic wastes, paper, glass, cans and building rubble which is re-routed to avoid disposal at landfills.

Some redundant electronic items collected at the stations are processed by specialist organisations who repair and re-assemble certain items for the benefit of disadvantaged communities, NGO's and schools.

Every aspect of Transfer Station management endorses Interwastes' stated principle of utilising landfill as an absolute last resort.



Landfill Management

Interwaste understands that landfill will remain the ultimate destination for the vast majority of our society's waste in the years to come. As such the responsibility to ensure that these sites are utilised in a manner that does minimum damage to the environment is an onerous one. Far from being simply a landfill user, the company works closely with its' strategic partners in landfill management to ensure that the highest levels of proper practice are adhered to at all times.



Through its' association with Enviro-Fill (Pty) Ltd., the company operates and manages over 30 landfill sites across the country, handling approximately 2,5 million tonnes of waste annually. These sites constitute a crucial link in the waste management chain, and the need for them to function safely and efficiently, often over decades, is a demanding area of operation. Opportunities exist at many of these facilities to minimise and reutilise waste. Large volumes of garden greens are chipped on-site and re-routed to various compost making facilities, relieving pressure on landfill volumes and generating a valuable resource in the process. Other recycling initiatives involving specific waste streams provide employment opportunities, often in areas where they are sorely needed.

The company is closely involved with final landfill site reclamation projects to ensure that, once fully utilised, they are decommissioned and returned to as close their original state as possible.
