

HAZMAT INCIDENT RESPONSE



The volume of dangerous and hazardous material transported on South African roads is increasing daily. With this increase comes the inevitable rise in the risk of accidental spillage and contamination of the environment. Authorities have taken note of this situation and have enacted new and tighter legislation in terms of the National Road Traffic Act 93/1996. One aspect of this legislation dictates that any carrier of potentially hazardous material must be adequately insured to cover civil liability, recovery and rehabilitation of the environment.

To minimise this risk and reduce possible losses it is essential that the carrier has the support of an organisation that works in close co-operation with the local police and emergency services. Hazmat 1 will ensure that any accidental spill is handled in the most efficient and professional manner possible.

Hazmat 1 response vehicles are deployed at situations requiring the use of its specialised teams and state-of-the-art equipment to ensure the safe containment, clean-up and disposal of all types of material.

Hazmat 1 vehicles are custom designed units fitted to carry every piece of equipment likely to be called upon in an emergency situation. All crew members are trained to a minimum of 1st Respondant level with most having attained Incident Commander status. Ongoing crew training is a vital aspect of operations.
