

SAFE DISPOSAL OPERATIONS



There has always been a need for the destruction and safe disposal of servicable yet unwanted goods. Items such as pharmaceuticals, confidential documentation and redundant consumables such as counterfeit goods, full tins, CD's and videos, frozen foods, etc. often require total destruction to ensure that company branding, quality, confidentiality and market integrity is protected.



Safe Disposal containers vary in size, are fully welded and have closed tops and lockable lids. They are used for the collection of goods for safe disposal. Clients are welcome to observe the entire destruction process after which a Certificate of Safe Disposal is issued.



Incineration can be effected after all safe disposal goods have been boxed, labeled and securely sealed. The goods are then transported and loaded into a licensed incinerator burning at a minimum of 1100°C for total destruction.

Alternatively, full Safe Disposal containers can be collected and transported to a licensed landfill facility where a 2 metre deep trench is excavated. The goods are then tipped, crushed and buried by a 35 tonne landfill compactor.

The static D-Structa and mobile PowerShredder are 100% efficient shredders that safely render goods totally unusable at a rates of up to 60m³ per hour. Security is guaranteed as goods to be destroyed arrive into a securely fenced compound for shredding.



The debris is then reloaded for disposal at a landfill-site. The PowerShredder can also be utilised at the clients' premises where the shredded waste is loaded directly by conveyor into bins for final disposal. Any liquid filled products are destroyed with the liquid content directed into a holding tank for separate disposal.

Incineration Services



In some cases the incineration of waste products is seen as the best alternative to disposal once all other avenues have been explored and discounted. Incineration lends itself to the complete destruction of, for example, redundant pharmaceuticals and persistent high-hazard chemicals where disposal to landfill would not be desirable and in some cases is outlawed.

Interwaste has partnerships with incinerator service suppliers to ensure the safe disposal of these waste types in line with current legislative standards.
